**“REGULATIONS IN TERMS OF SECTION 4C (2) (a) AND (b) OF THE ICASA ACT  
(ACT NO. 13 OF 2000)”**

## SCHEDULE

### 1. Definitions

In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise indicates, a word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the ICASA Act, has the meaning so assigned:

**“ICASA Act”** means the Independent Communications Authority of South Africa Act, 2000 (Act No. 13 of 2000) as amended.

**“Prescribed form”** means a notice in terms of section 4C (2) (a) and (b) of the ICASA Act.

### 2. Purpose

The purpose of these Regulations is to prescribe a form in terms of which the Authority, during the conduct of an inquiry in terms of section 4B of the ICASA Act and subject to section 4D of the ICASA Act and any law governing privilege, may:

- (a) through the person presiding at such inquiry, by notice in writing, require from any person such particulars and information as may be reasonably necessary; and
- (b) by notice in writing under the hand of a councillor, addressed and delivered by an authorised person or sheriff to any person, require such person to:
  - (i) appear before it at the date, time and place specified in the notice;
  - (ii) make a statement; and
  - (iii) submit to it all the documents or objects in the possession or custody or under the control of any such person which may be reasonably necessary.

### **3. Prescribed Form**

The notice in terms of section 4C (2) (a) and (b) of the ICASA Act shall be in the format as laid out in the Annexure.

### **4. Short Title and Commencement**

These Regulations are called the Inquiry Prescribed Form Regulations 2015 and shall come into operation upon publication in the Government gazette.
